GENERAL INFORMATION

Peace Day started in 2018 as a free event for families with elementary-age children, focusing on positive communication and healthy relationships in a fun and accessible manner. It includes a take-home Peace Tote Bag for ongoing family skill-building and learning.

ENGAGING COMMUNITY AT PEACE DAY

This event gathers metro-area families at TCC for a day of fun activities that promote conflict transformation themes like naming emotions, discussing feelings with trusted adults and managing anger and frustration creatively. And lots of kid-friendly fun, like face painting and bubbles as well!

THE PEACE TOTE BAGS THIS YEAR

Each family will receive a Peace Tote Bag to fill with activities that will be available at each program station, including:

- individual and family activities
- crafts and games
- skill-building exercises

The activities aim to boost connection and emotional self-awareness, strengthen relationships between children and trusted adults & promote positive self-talk while teaching healthy anger-management strategies.
